All net proceeds of the tournament will go to the Pacific Northwest Angelman Syndrome Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. The purpose of this tournament is to create awareness of Angelman Syndrome (AS) and help fund the continued efforts of PNWASF.

Angelman Syndrome is a genetic disorder first identified by Dr. Harry Angelman, an English physician, in 1965. Persons with Angelman Syndrome experience significant mental delay and retardation, including profound speech impairment, movement or balance disorder, and have characteristic facial appearance and behavior. It is believed that perhaps thousands of additional individuals with AS remain undiagnosed, or have been misdiagnosed with cerebral palsy, autism, or other neurological disorders.

Consequently, heightened awareness by educators, the medical community, and the general public about the existence and characteristics of AS is critical. It is imperative to identify individuals with AS and to develop appropriate medical and therapeutic treatments for this rare genetic disorder. As children with AS are studied, many educational and behavioral interventions have been shown to be effective in the areas of communication, sleep disturbances, seizure control, fine and gross motor skills and general behavior.

Funds raised by the current and previous tournaments have enabled PNWASF to produce and distribute detailed information regarding AS to local medical personnel and other interested individuals, host and support conferences regarding AS, maintain a current website and provide opportunities for regional families to exchange information, concerns and strategies related to life with AS family members.

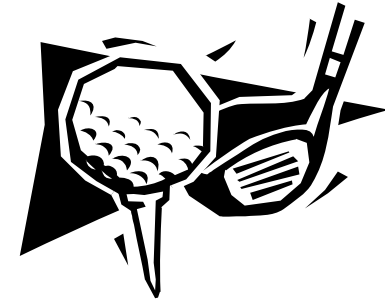
